The Division for Learning Disabilities' Outstanding Educator-of-the-Year Awards recognize outstanding professionals who serve students with specific learning disabilities. The award consists of

- A \$500 stipend,
- Up to \$1500 in travel expenses for presentation of the award at the DLD business meeting, held during CEC's annual convention, and
- A commemorative plaque.
